Ex Parte Disclosure Statement for Mayor Kitty Piercy

Dated June 12, 2013

To my knowledge, I have not had any specific discussions regarding the particular EWEB Master Plan proposals before the City Council. I have had discussions with members of the public who have expressed interest in developing the EWEB property in particular ways. However, those discussions were general in nature and did not express support or opposition to the particular plan amendments, code changes and zone changes being proposed.

To the best of my recollection, I have not had any discussions, nor have I sent or received e-mails, regarding the EWEB master plan issue.

I have had discussions with members of the public who have expressed particular views about how the EWEB property might or should be developed or preserved. Different people I have spoken with have expressed many differing views on the subject. However, in general I do not recall that I have had any specific conversations related to the specific EWEB master plan proposals that are currently before the city council.

Ex Parte Disclosure Statement for City Council Member Alan Zelenka

Dated June 12, 2013

As far as I can remember, I have not discussed the EWEB master plan issue with anyone, either in person or via e-mail, outside of public meetings. I have read articles related to the matter in the Register-Guard and have watched and listened to television and radio news reports on the issue.

Ex Parte Disclosure Statement for City Council Member George Poling

Dated June 12, 2013

I have had discussions with citizens regarding the EWEB Master Plan applications in public meetings, open houses and at organized presentations to neighborhood association groups. Those discussions were general in nature, and I do not specifically recall the exact topics discussed. In the past year, I have avoided conversations with individuals regarding this issue because of my involvement as a city councilor. I have received general e-mails from city staff and the mayor, addressed to the entire council regarding the issue, but as far as I can remember, I have not exchanged e-mails with members of the general public regarding this issue.

Ex Parte Disclosure Statement for City Council Member Mike Clark

Dated June 12, 2013

I have spoken with and to more people and groups than I can recall over the last several years about my vision for a city hall on the EWEB admin property section and how that could affect other parts of the EWEB property and my thoughts about their development over time.

I have also written several articles for the newspaper and given speeches to groups like the city club on the subject.

Although I have thoughts and preferences, I can certainly make an unbiased decision based on the record and the law.

Ex Parte Disclosure Statement for City Council Member Greg Evans

Dated June 12, 2013

To the best of my recollection, I have not had any discussions, nor have I sent or received e-mails, regarding the EWEB master plan issue.

Ex Parte Disclosure Statement for City Council Member Clair Syrett

Dated June 12, 2013

I have only been on the city council since October, 2012, and so have not had the long history with this issue that other councilors might have had. As far as I can remember, I have not discussed this issue with anyone, either in person or via e-mail, other than my husband, outside of public meetings. I merely mentioned the fact of the master plan to my husband and that new development was being proposed for the EWEB site.

Ex Parte Disclosure Statement for City Council Member Chris Pryor

Dated June 12, 2013

I have not had any discussions with interested parties or members of the general public regarding the EWEB Master Plan application. I was aware that at least a portion of this issue was regarded as quasi-judicial in nature and so I avoided having discussions about the issues involved.
