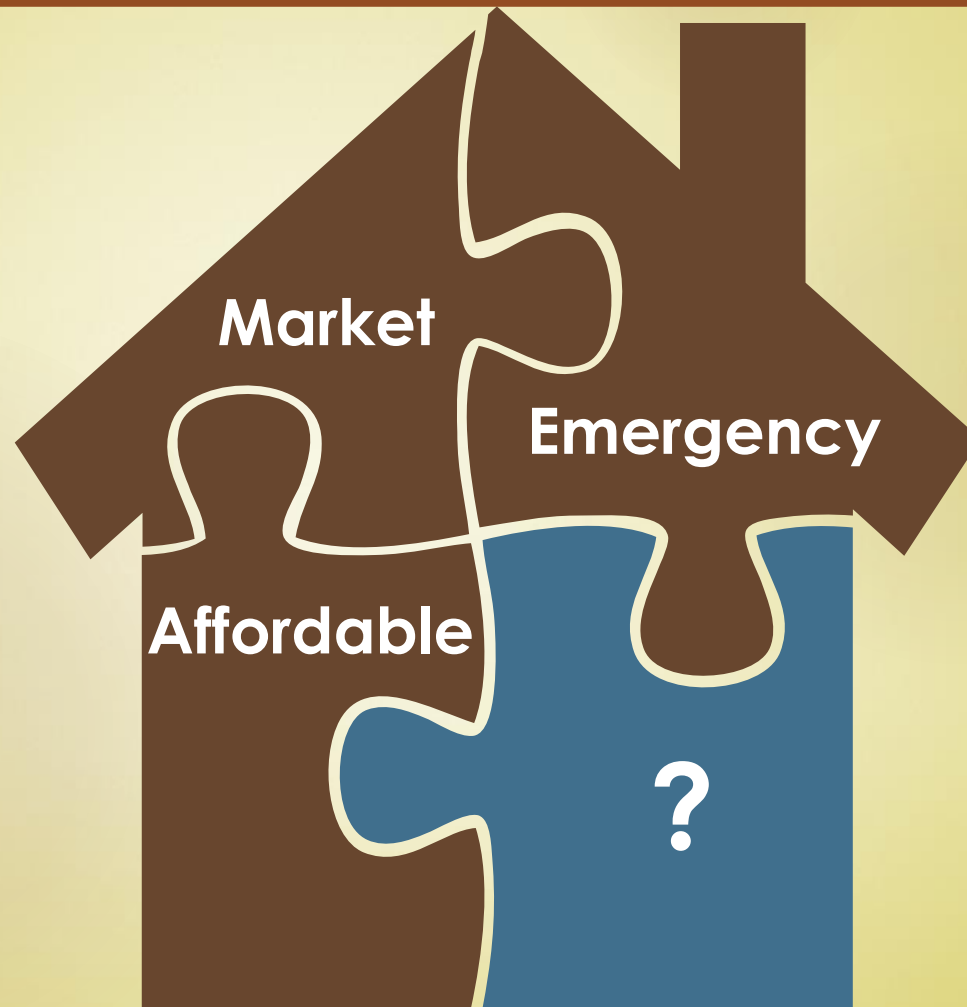


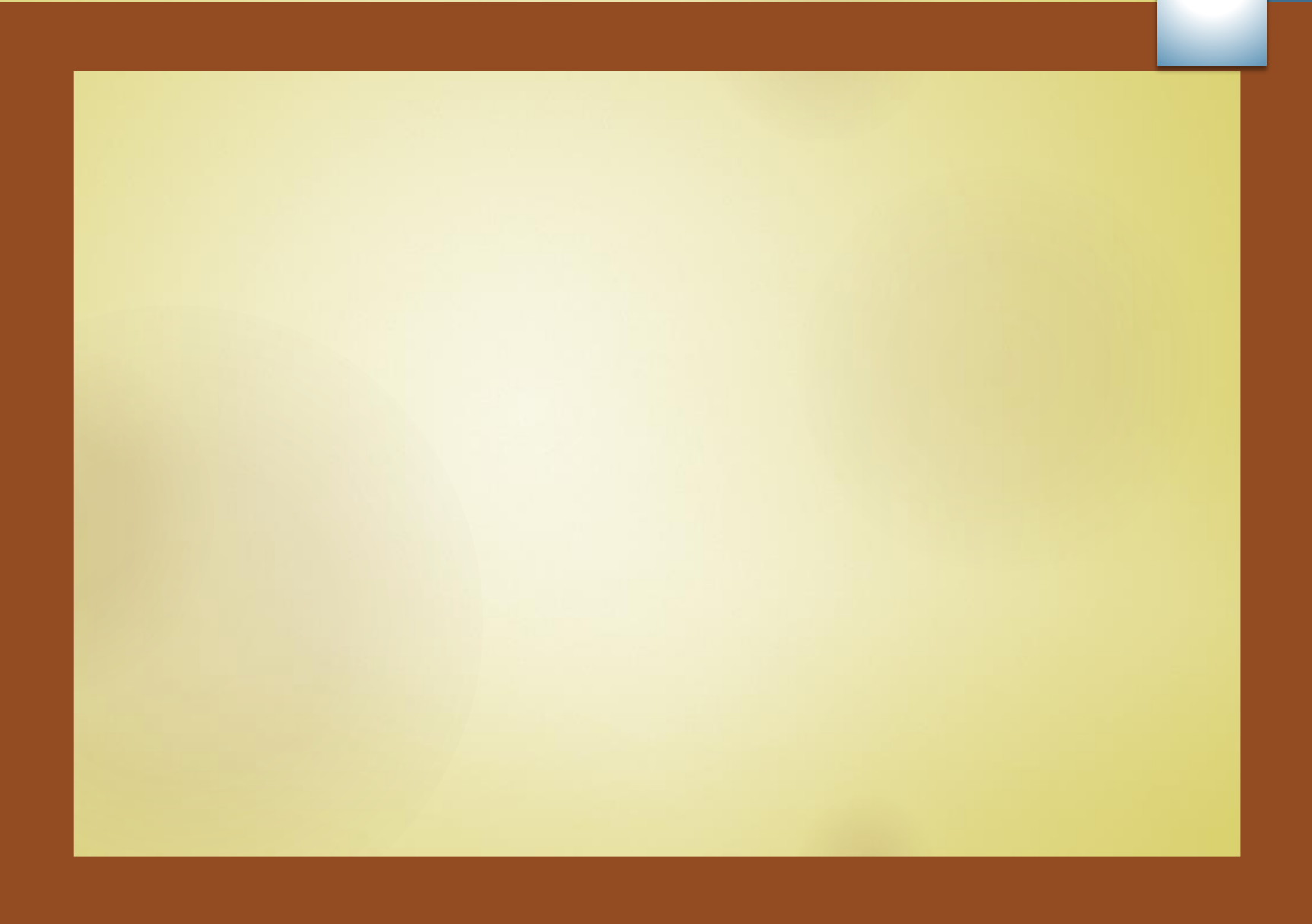

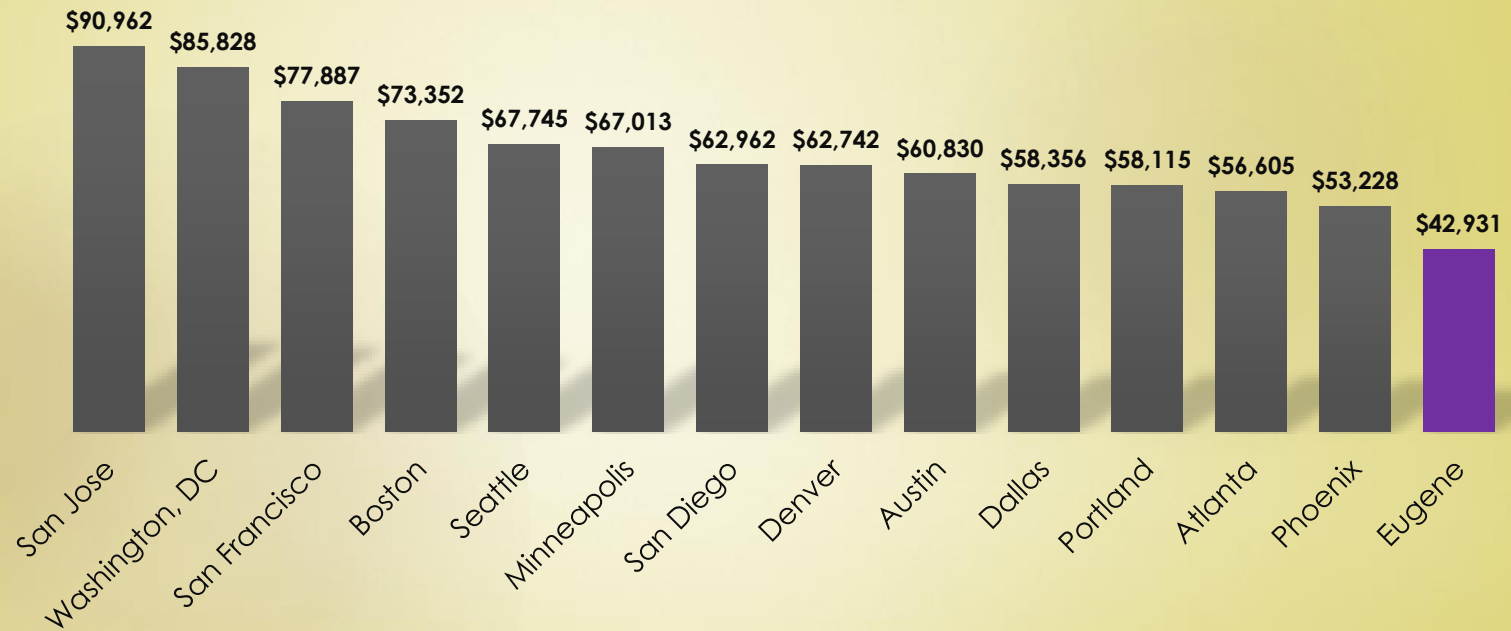

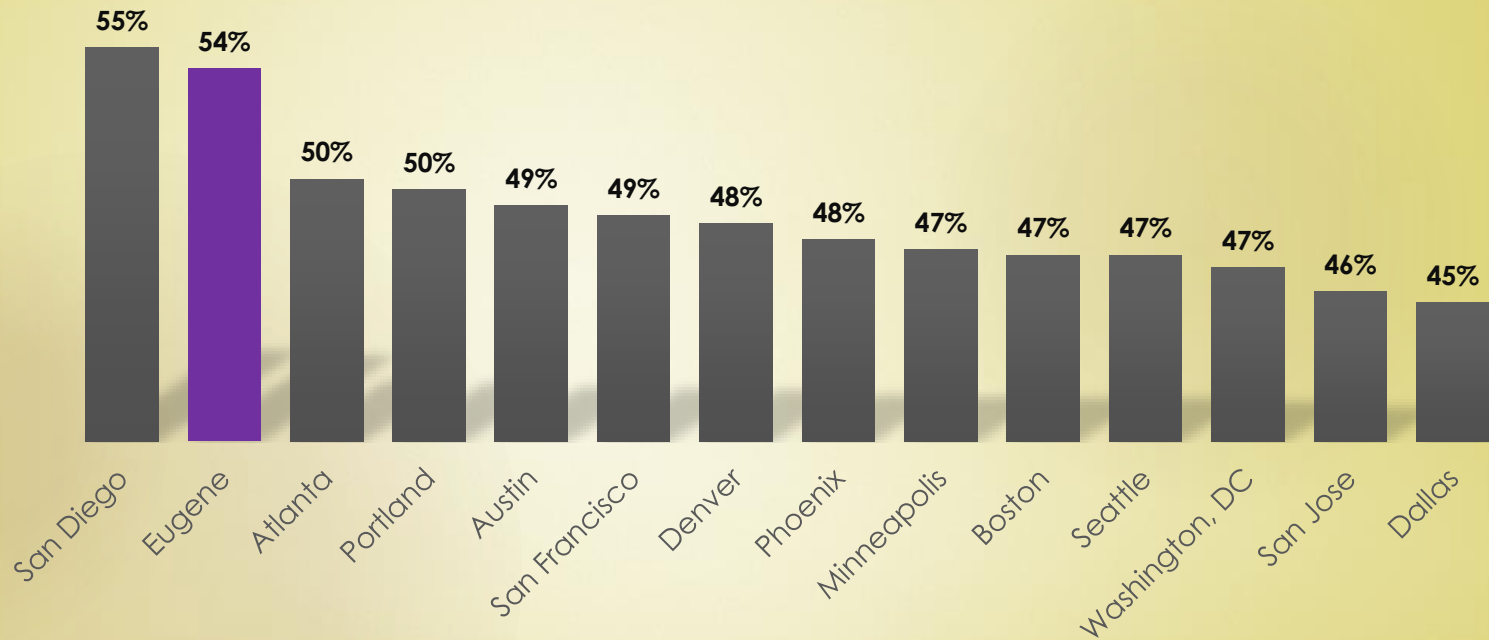

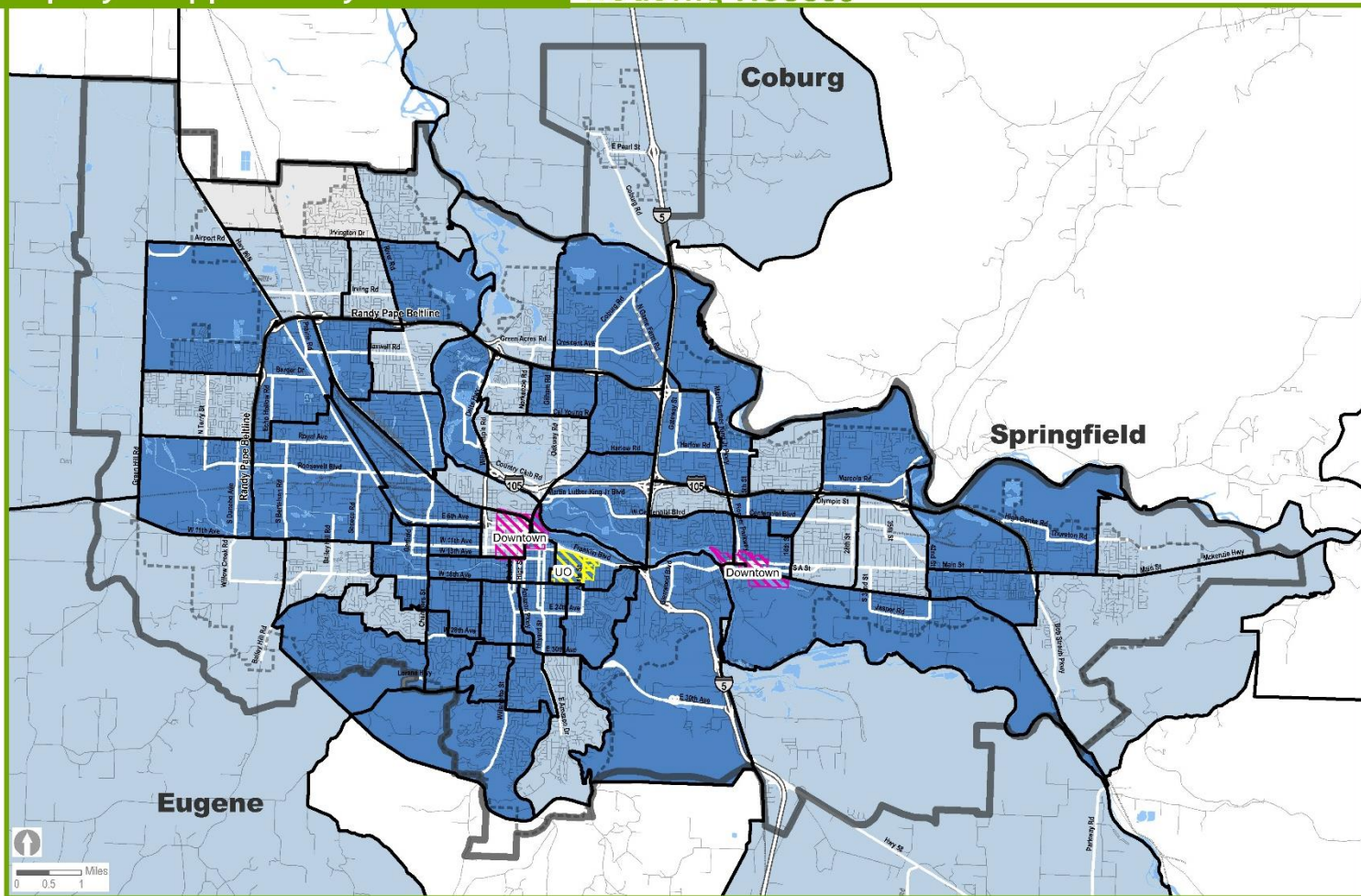
Median Rent, 2-Bedroom Apartment
