A RESOLUTION APPROVING OF MOVINGAHEAD LOCALLY PREFERRED ALTERNATIVES.

The City Council of the City of Eugene finds that:

A. The City of Eugene and Lane Transit District have entered into a partnership to coordinate transportation investments along key corridors, called MovingAhead.

B. MovingAhead supports the City's Envision Eugene, 2035 Transportation System Plan, Climate Action Plan 2.0, Vision Zero Action Plan, LTD's Long Range Transit Plan, and other community policies and plans.

C. As part of MovingAhead the City and LTD have held multiple corridor design workshops engaging members of the public to create conceptual designs, held open houses along the corridors, and conducted robust public involvement throughout the process.

D. City and LTD staff have engaged with residents, property owners, and businesses along the corridors and will continue to work with them in the development of future phases of the process.

E. Selection of a locally preferred alternative for each corridor will allow staff to conduct design refinement, coordinate with property owners and permitting agencies, schedule corridor improvements, and pursue funding.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EUGENE, a Municipal Corporation of the State of Oregon, as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. The following are the City of Eugene's locally preferred alternatives as described in the September 2018 "MovingAhead Streets and Places Reimagined Alternatives Analysis Report":

- Enhanced Corridor on the Highway 99 Corridor
- EmX on the River Road Corridor
- No Build on the 30th Avenue to LCC Corridor
- Enhanced Corridor with further study on the Coburg Road Corridor
- <u>Enhanced Corridor</u> on the Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard Corridor

<u>Section 2</u>. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
