ISSUE STATEMENT

The Agency Board is required to take action on this item. Urban Renewal Agency Board approval of the second Supplemental Budget for FY10 is requested. Oregon Local Budget Law (ORS 294.480) allows for supplemental budgets for "an occurrence...which had not been ascertained at the time of the preparation of a budget for the current year...". This Supplemental Budget consists of \$100,000 in proposed changes to the FY10 Budget. A description of the proposed transaction is provided in Attachment A. This supplemental budget does not authorize any increased property tax levy.

BACKGROUND

Supplemental Budgets recognize new revenue and authorize other unanticipated changes in legal appropriations during a fiscal year.

RELATED CITY POLICIES

This transaction conforms to the City's Financial Management Goals and Policies.

AGENCY OPTIONS

Particular requests requiring more information or discussion may be removed from the supplemental budget and delayed for action in a future supplemental budget in FY11. In certain cases, there may be a financial or legal impact to delaying budget approval. The Agency Board may also adopt amended appropriation amounts or funding sources for specific requests in the supplemental budget.

AGENCY DIRECTOR'S RECOMMENDATION

The Agency Director recommends approval of the attached resolution adopting the Supplemental Budget.

SUGGESTED MOTION

Move to adopt Resolution 1056 adopting the FY10 June Supplemental Budget; making appropriations for the Urban Renewal Agency for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2010.

**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET;
MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE URBAN RENEWAL AGENCY
OF THE CITY OF EUGENE
FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 2009,
AND ENDING JUNE 30, 2010**

The Urban Renewal Agency of the City of Eugene finds that adopting the Supplemental Budget and making appropriations is necessary under ORS 294.480.

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE URBAN RENEWAL AGENCY OF THE CITY OF EUGENE as follows:

Section 1.

That the Supplemental Budget for the Urban Renewal Agency of the City of Eugene, Oregon, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2010, as set forth in attached Exhibit "A" is hereby adopted.

Section 2.

The supplemental amounts for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2010, and for the purposes shown in attached Exhibit "A" are hereby appropriated.

Section 3.

That this Supplemental Budget is prepared in accordance with ORS 294.480(1)(a), which authorizes the formulation of a supplemental budget resulting from "An occurrence or condition which had not been ascertained at the time of the preparation of a budget for the current year or current budget period which requires a change in financial planning." This Supplemental Budget was published in accordance with ORS 294.480(4).

Section 4.

This resolution complies with ORS 294.480(5), and does not authorize an increase in the levy of property taxes above the amount published in the Annual Budget publication.

The foregoing resolution adopted this 28th day of June, 2010.
