

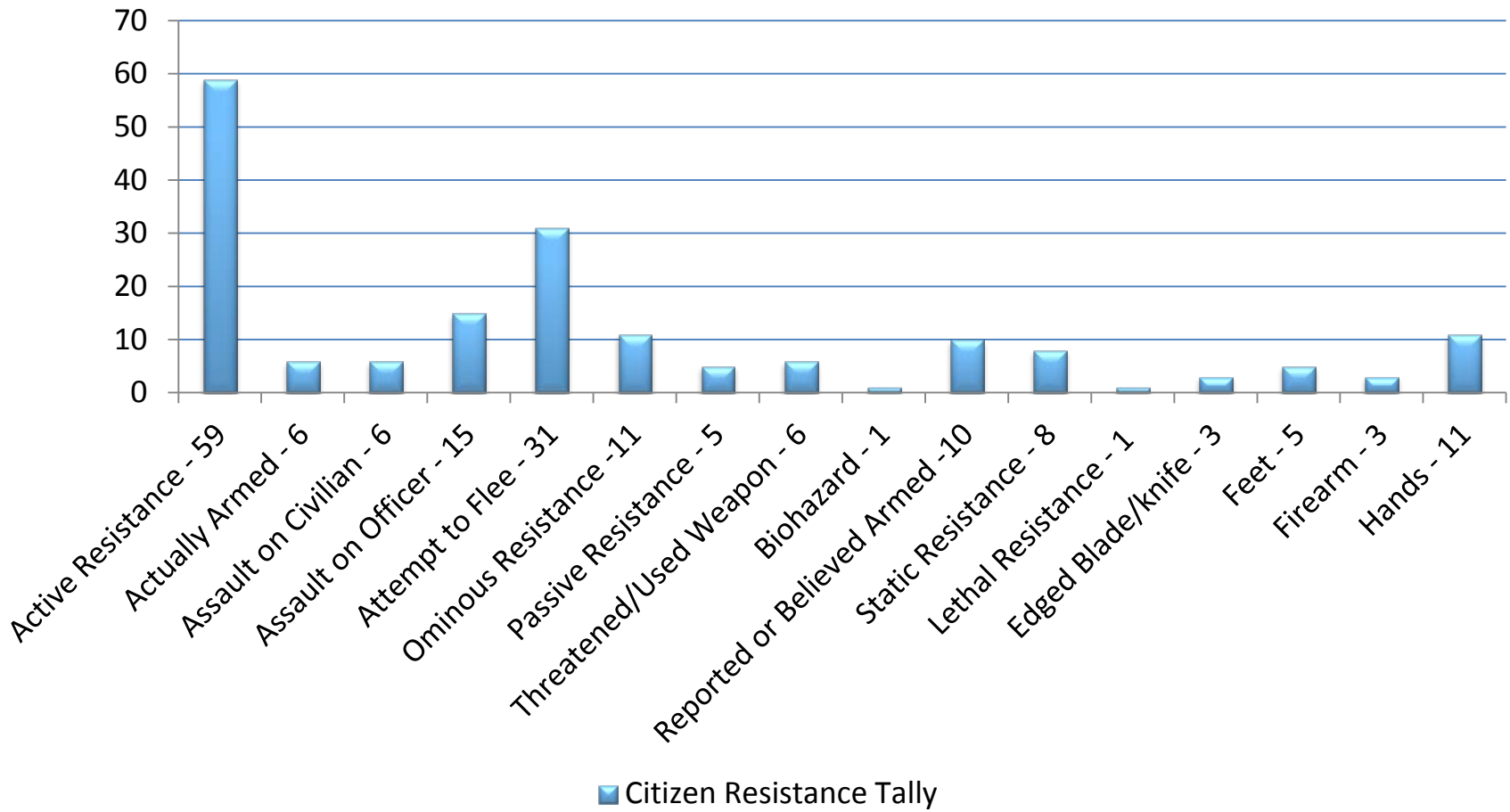

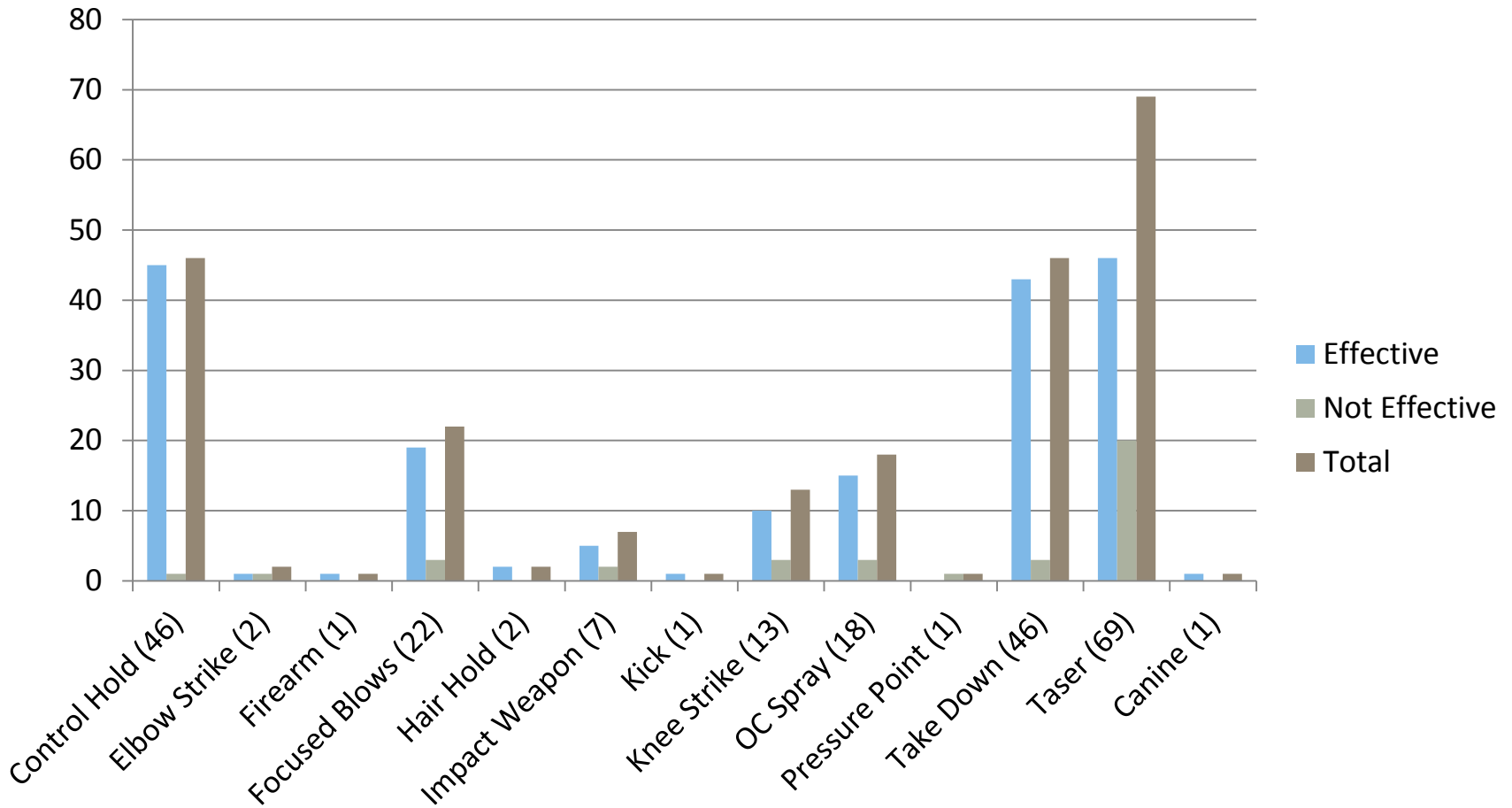

## 130 Use of Force Reports



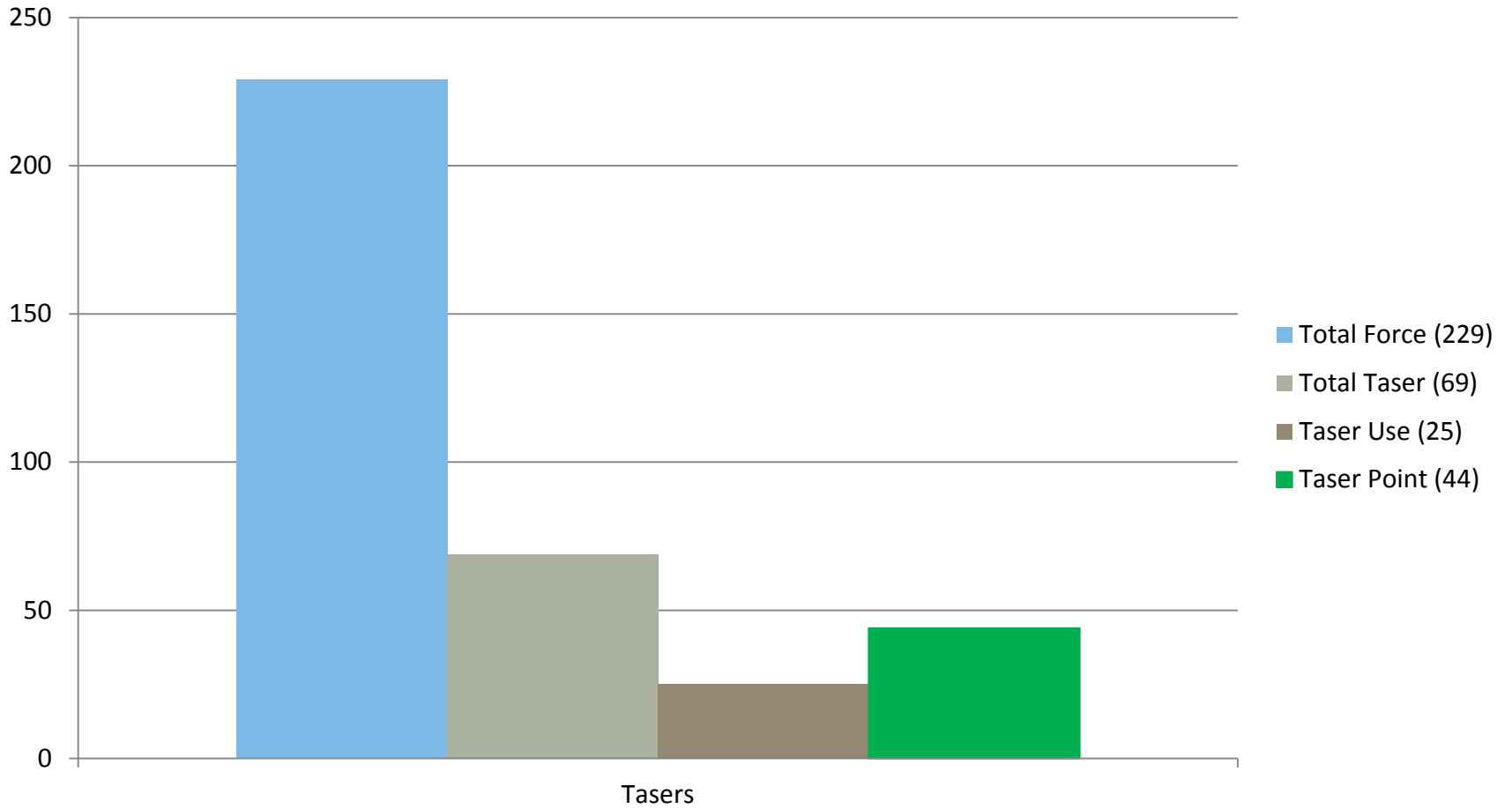


# Total Count of Force Used



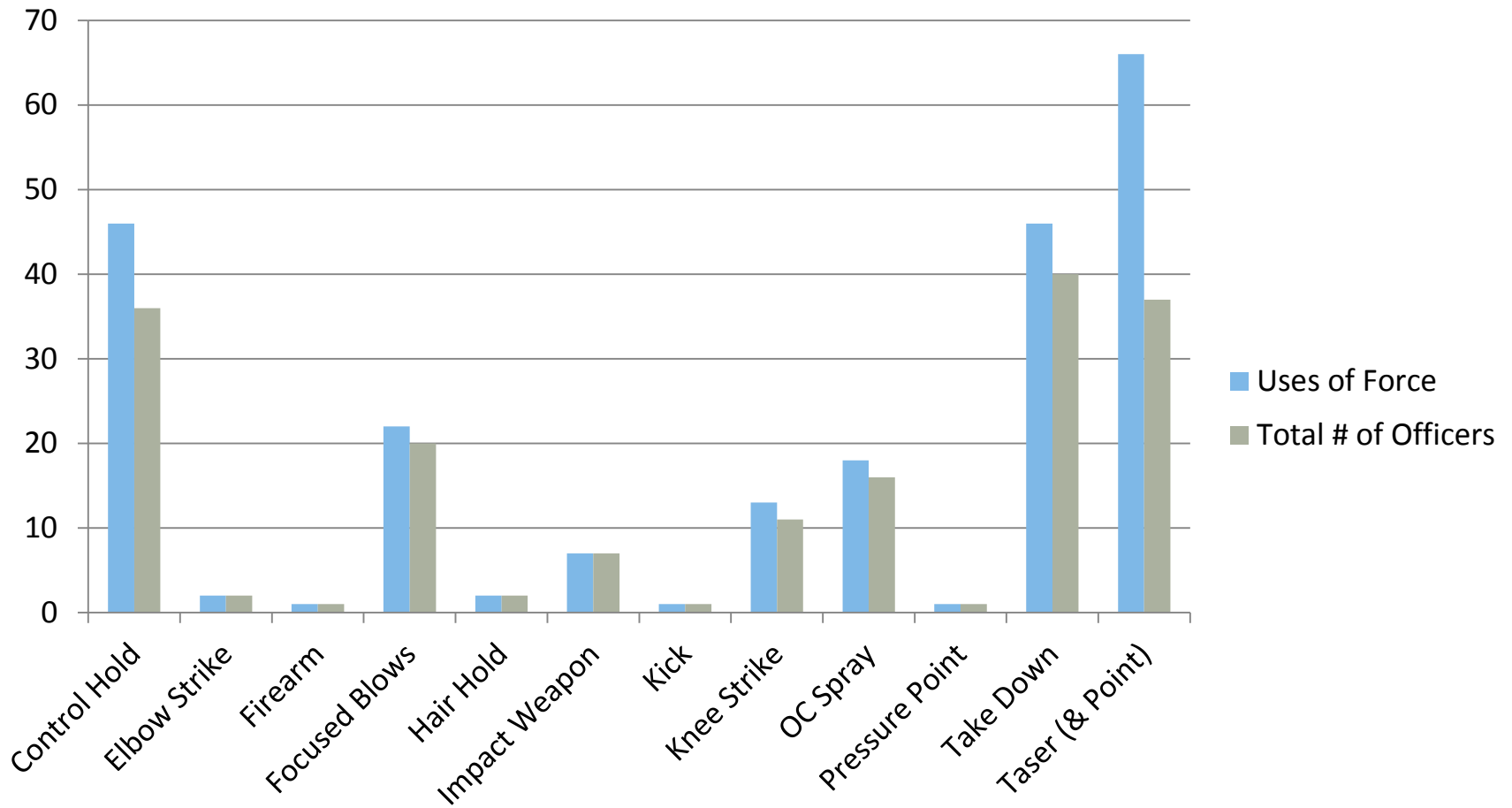

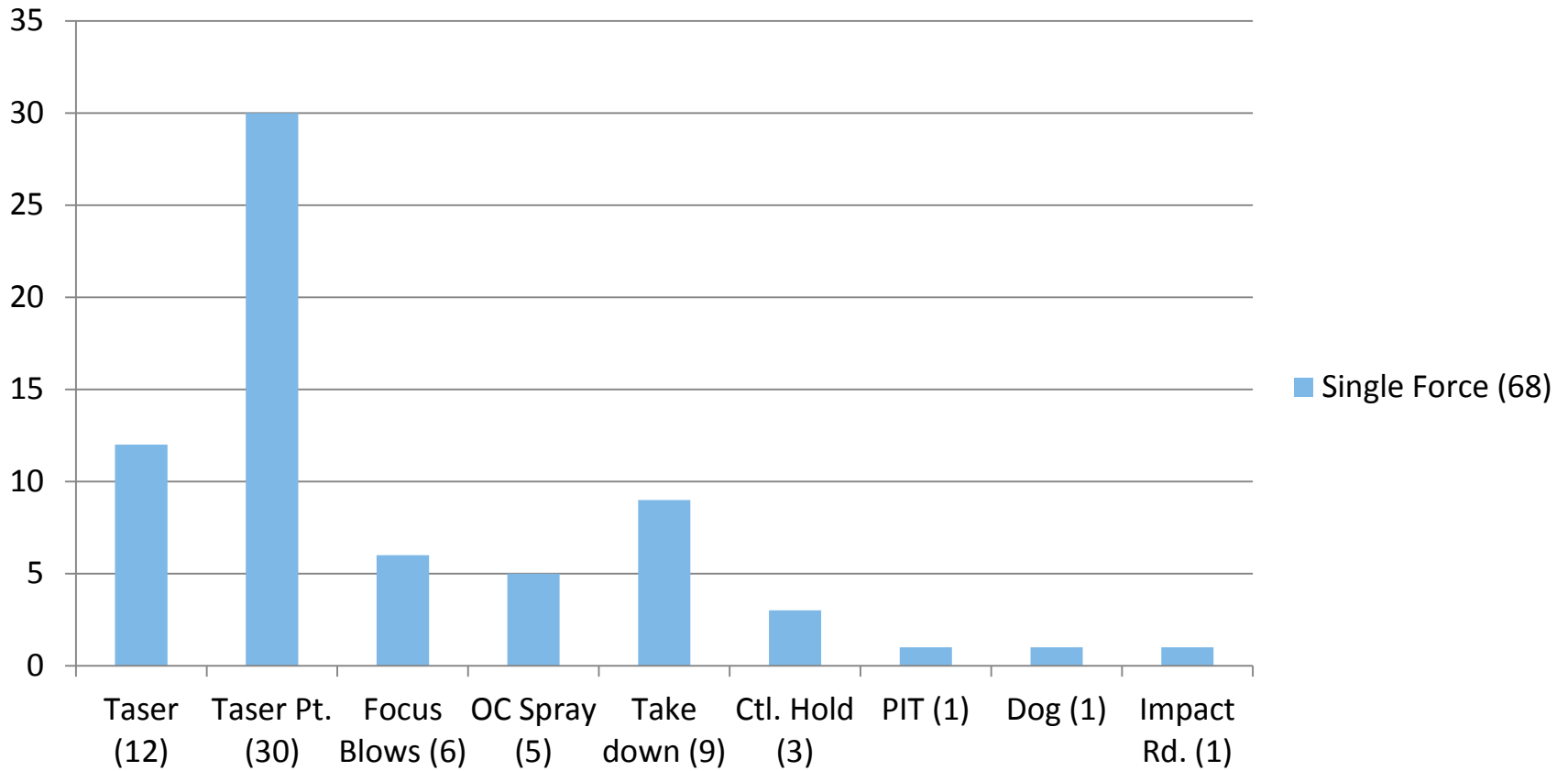

# Single Force (of 130 Incidents)

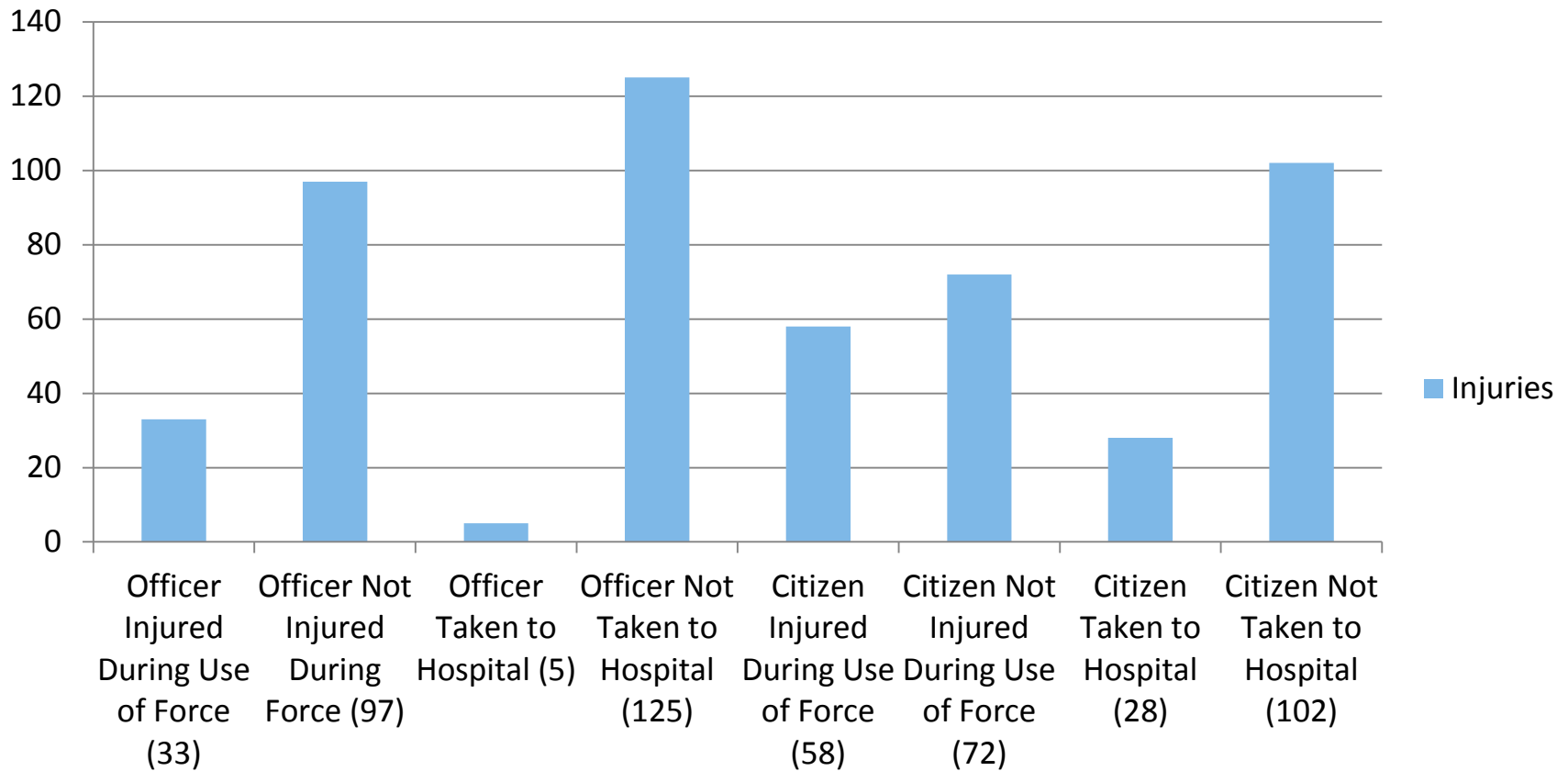

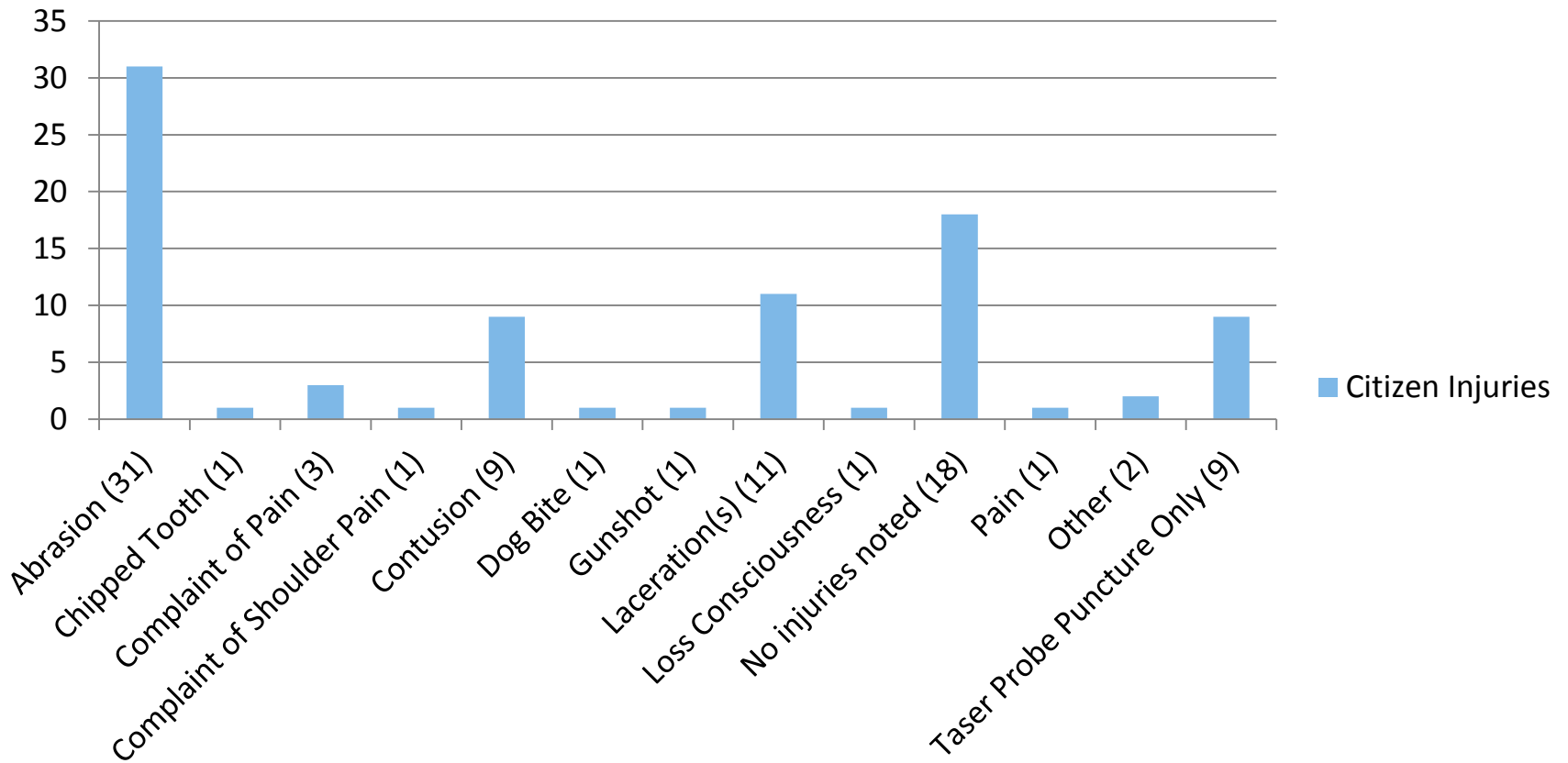

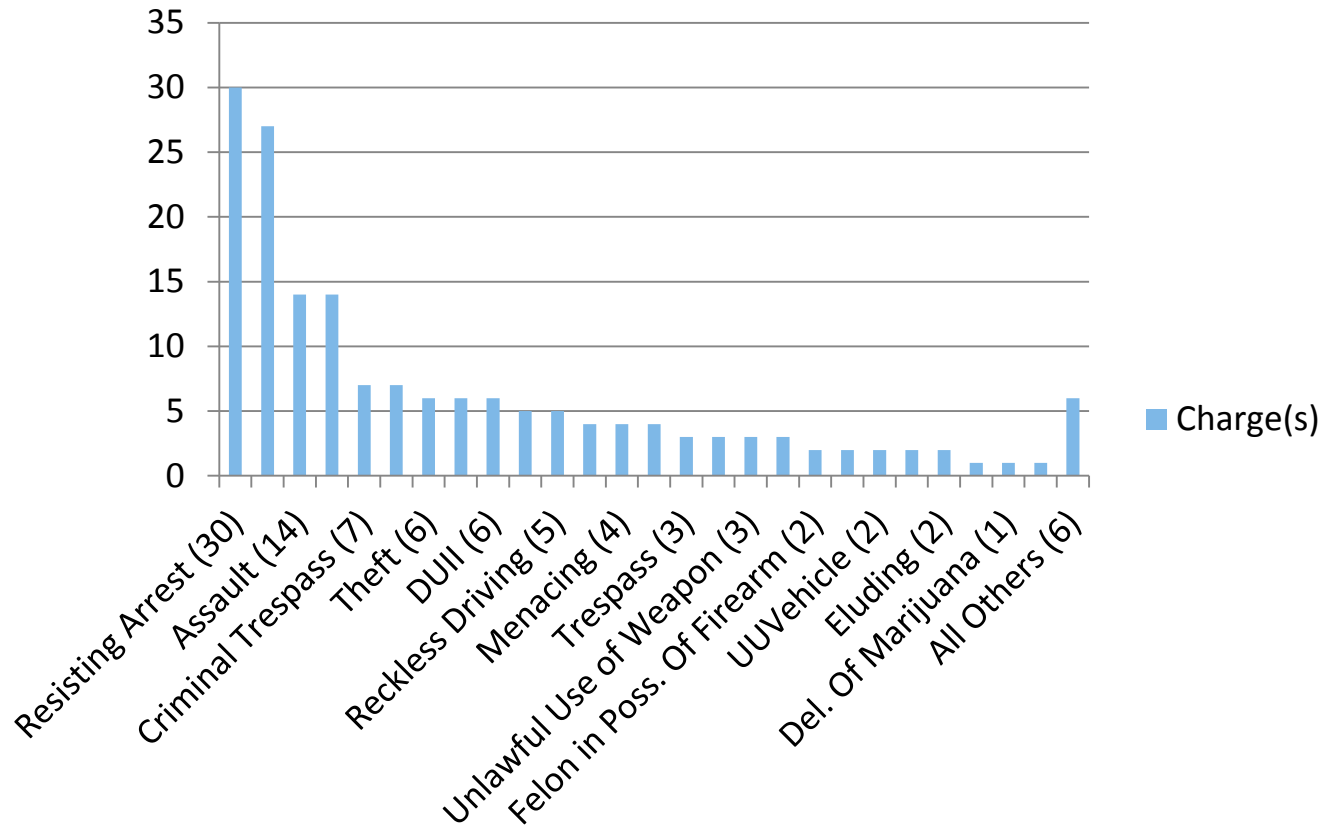
# Officer Assessment of Person's Condition

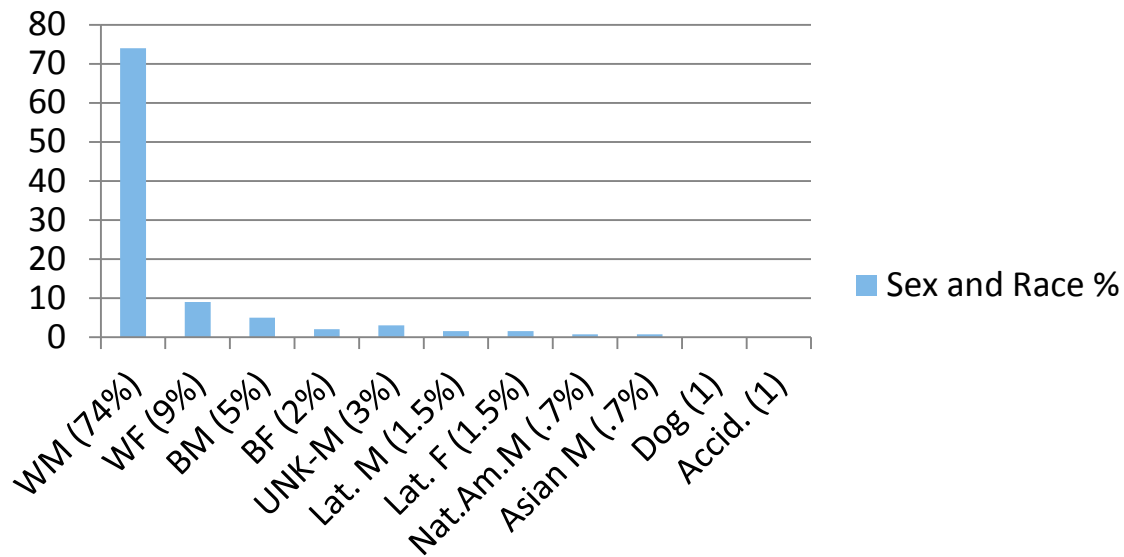

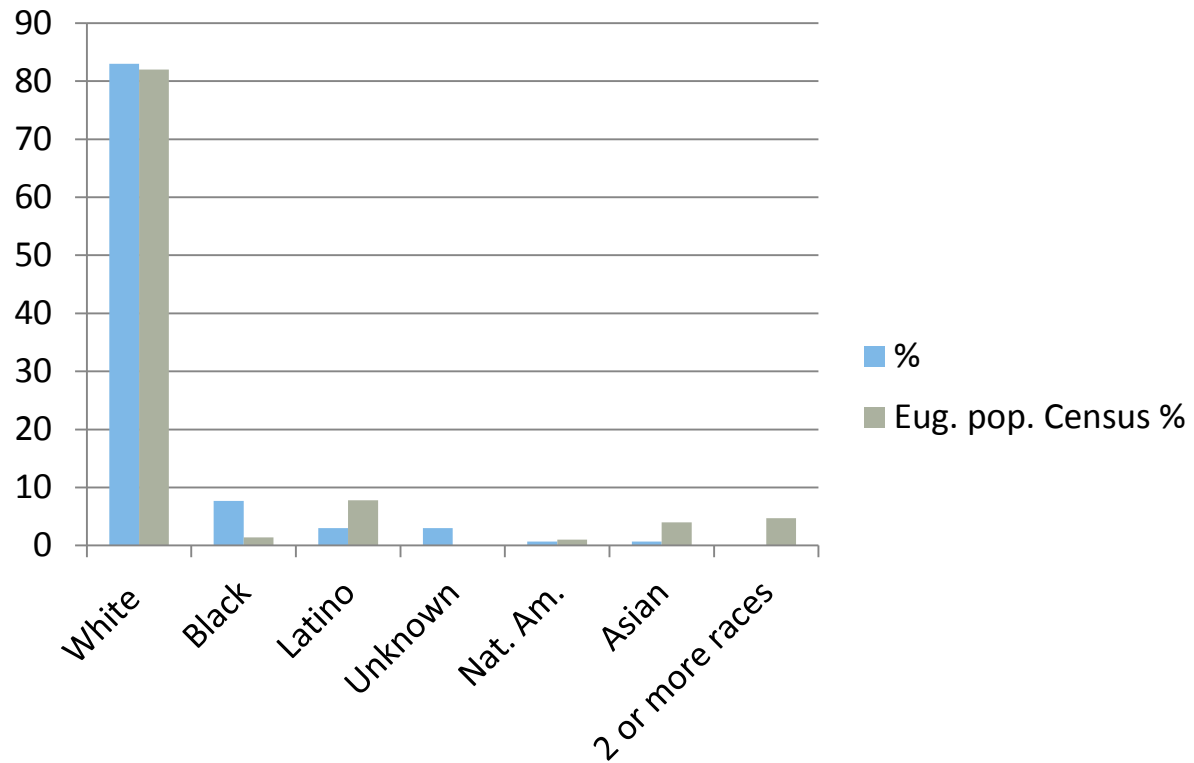
# Sex and Race (%)

## Race/Ethnicity – A Glance at 2014

- Less than 0.1% (or about one per 1,000) of all physical arrests of African-Americans results in a reportable use of force, including Taser points.
- Less than 0.02% (or about one per 4,000) of all physical arrests of Latinos results in a reportable use of force, including Taser points.
