Policy Framework for SDCs

- Growth Management Policy 14
 - *Development shall be required to pay the full cost of extending infrastructure and services, except that the City will examine ways to subsidize the costs of providing infrastructure or offer other incentives that support higher-density, in-fill, mixed-use, and redevelopment.*

Purpose of SDCs

- New development funds its fair share of infrastructure costs
- Two forms of SDCs - reimbursement and improvement fees
- Supports five primary infrastructure systems
 - Wastewater,
 - Stormwater,
 - Parks,
 - Transportation,
 - Water

Use of SDCs

- Types of projects funded by SDCs include:
 - Pavement preservation on arterial & collector streets
 - Traffic signals and other transportation improvements
 - Off-street bicycle paths
 - Parks land acquisition and development
 - Wastewater system expansion and rehabilitation
 - Stormwater expansion and rehabilitation

SDC Revenues and Expenditures

| | 2010 | 2011 | 2012 | 2013 | 2014 |
|--------------|---------------|---------------|---------------|---------------|---------------|
| Revenues | \$2.5 million | \$2.2 million | \$4.8 million | \$4.2 million | \$7.5 million |
| Expenditures | \$2.9 million | \$1.8 million | \$1.9 million | \$1.1 million | \$3.5 million |

SDC Implications for Development

- SDCs can be a significant part of a development project's costs
- Amount depends on type & size of development – systems capacity demand

Comparison of SDC to Project Value for Example Development Types

| Example Development Types | Total SDC* (assumes no credits) | Estimated Construction Value** | SDC as Percentage of Value |
|---|--|---------------------------------------|-----------------------------------|
| Single Family Dwelling - 2,000 sq. ft. | \$9,494 | \$255,900 | 3.71% |
| Multifamily - 60-unit Apartment | \$381,902 | \$7,922,227 | 4.82% |
| Office Building - 20,000 sq. ft. | \$131,331 | \$2,951,000 | 4.45% |
| Low Turnover Restaurant - 7,363 sq. ft. | \$260,090 | \$1,119,029 | 23.24% |
| Supermarket 49,556 sq. ft. | \$1,172,377 | \$5,270,281 | 22.25% |

SDC Implications for Development

- SDCs can be significant ~ 1% - 20+% of a development project's construction costs
- Amount depends on type & size of development – systems capacity demand
- **SDCs paid, or contract to pay, at the time of issuance of a building permit**
- **SDC exemptions or credits provide reductions and incentives**
