Eugene City Council Public Hearing Eugene, Oregon 97401

July 15, 2024

Mayor Vinis opened the July 15, 2024, public hearing of the Eugene City Council in hybrid in-person and virtual format at 500 E. 4th Avenue, Eugene, OR 97401, North Building.

1. PUBLIC HEARING: An Ordinance Concerning the Central Commercial Sign Code Standards and the Downtown Riverfront Special Area Zone, Amending Section 9.6670(3) of the Eugene Code, 1971.

Mayor Vinis opened the public hearing.

City Manager, Sarah Medary, introduced the topic and provided background information.

Mayor Vinis provided time for Council members to disclose any bias, conflicts of interest, ex parte communications or abstentions pursuant to Eugene Code 9.7065(5).
